Regular homework **will** improve your child's performance.

**All** children are required to read for 10 minutes **each day at home**.

Children **learning** to read need to read to an adult **each day at home**.

**Good readers** need to read silently on their own **each day at home**.

Spellings and tables tasks must be done throughout the week, not the just on the night before the test.

Tasks must be handed in by the deadline set.

These timings/day allocations are guidance. You may of course do the written homework over the weekend should you wish. You may also decide to spend more time on work/reading/projects that interest your child.

This programme meets the Government recommendations on homework at Key Stage 2 and exceeds the recommended minimum time.
