

Covid Catch up Premium Strategy 2020-21 at Fitzjohn's

What is it?

The government announced £1 billion in funding to support children and young people to catch up lost time after school closure. This is especially important for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds.

Percentage of disadvantaged pupils in each class 2020-21:

Reception –10%

Year 1 – 7%

Year 2 – 13%

Year 3 – 10%

Year 4 – 13%

Year 5 – 23%

Year 6 – 14%

Whole School 13%

National 24%

How much Catch up funding will we receive for the 2020-21 academic year?

The government has said that schools will receive £80 per pupil in two phases making a total of £16,080.

How will we spend the funding?

1. Support teacher mainly focusing on Y3 (now Y4) and Y4 (now Y5) **as that's where we identified the most gaps**. The support teacher will also work with some groups and 1/1.

1. All pupils receiving extra support meet their challenging targets in reading, writing and maths
2. Attainment in reading, writing and maths increases
