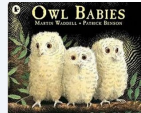

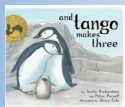
Settling in

The children will explore how all families are unique.



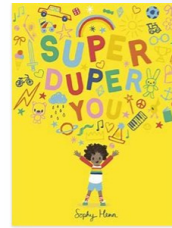
Feelings

angry/love.



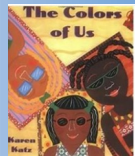
All about me
