Key Events: Village Walk, Rosh Hashana, Halloween

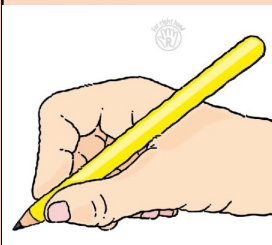
Personal, Emotional and Social Development
