

**It's spring time and we're into the last term of the year.** We're so glad to be able to go ahead with our traditional spring and summer events that bring our Fitzjohn's community together, and make a last push towards smashing our annual fundraising target!

## Fundraising news

**Since the beginning of the school year, we raised over £67,000 already.**

It's been brilliant having our school community come together, most recently for the jumble sale that raised £1,200 in just over an hour (!!). Thanks everyone for your participation and generosity.



How our donations are spent (partial list):

- ✓ **More music** - £10K – we doubled the amount of music provision and now all classes R-Y6 have weekly music lessons.
- ✓ **Better IT** - £10K - we've increased (and replaced) the number of iPads, chrome books and storage.
- ✓ **Fun playground** - £5k - we continue to add to and develop our play spaces.
- ✓ **Phonic Reading Books** - £5k – new sets for Nursery, Reception, Y1 and Y2.

**Our annual target is £75,000.**
